ACCORDING TO THE UNHCR, CHILDREN ACCOUNT FOR 30% OF THE WORLD'S POPULATION, BUT AN ESTIMATED **42%** OF ALL FORCIBLY DISPLACED PEOPLE. RECENT DATA SHOWS THAT MANY CHILDREN BORN IN DISPLACEMENT ARE AT RISK OF REMAINING IN EXILE FOR MANY YEARS... SOME POTENTIALLY FOR THE REST OF THEIR LIVES.
